Next, explore Tan Teng Niah, a distinctive Chinese villa amidst shophouses, and head over to the Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple, one of Singapore's oldest Hindu temples, where you can seek blessings from the local priest. The tour ends at the central meeting point before returning to your hotel or venturing further into the heart of Singapore.
