

From Michelin-starred restaurants to street food joints and hole-in-the-wall establishments that have also received the elusive star, you will not run out of excellent options to sample a vast array of local cuisine in Bangkok. Our Street Eat tour stands out for taking you to places that are adored by the locals, on a vehicle that best symbolises the vibrant, boisterous and dynamic city of Bangkok – the Tuk-Tuk.

So, stretch your legs and hold on tight as we effortlessly zigzag through the frenetic Bangkok traffic and make stops at local markets, restaurants and historic sites to eat and see through neighbourhoods that form the cultural and culinary backbone of Thailand's capital.

The first stop is a Michelin Bib Gourmand-listed Pad Thai Restaurant to try the famed savoury and sweet noodle dish. Then we visit a local night market to try Thai delicacies ranging from grilled meat to coconut pudding. Take a short break from eating and stroll through Pak Klong Talat, Thailand's largest flower market, which comes to life especially at night. As an epic grand finale, our last stop is a riverside rooftop bar where you can take in the splendid views of the majestic Wat Arun temple while sipping on a cool drink.
